

On Sunday, 12/7, First Lutheran will be dedicating our new solar panel array after the 9:00am worship service!





In comparing General Fund income with **actual** expenses, you will see a shortfall of \$42,759. This compares to last month when the shortfall was \$33,037.

In using the straight line method of calculating the budget, general fund income was about \$64,866 under budget.

Using the historical average method of calculating the budget as shown above, you will see that the variance was a negative \$40,075.

Regular offering was \$66,132 under budget expectations through October, and less than 2024 by \$18,200.

General Fund offering for October was \$24,964. Historically, October results in 9.41% of general fund giving. This amount would be \$38,989.

1. National Influenza Vaccination Week (First week of December)

2. National Safe Toys and Gifts Month

If you're buying toys for children, check for age-appropriate labels, avoid small parts for little ones, and ensure gifts are free from choking hazards.

3. Handwashing Awareness Week (Early December)

Handwashing is one of the most effective ways to prevent the spread of illness during the winter season.

### Screenings and Health Maintenance

As we approach the end of the year, it's a great time to make sure your preventive care is up to date:

- Blood pressure check at least once a year.
- Cholesterol and blood sugar every 1-3 years, more often if you have risk factors.
- Mammogram and Pap test as recommended by your provider.
- Colon cancer screening beginning at age 45, or earlier if advised.
- Vaccinations Flu, COVID-19 boosters, pneumonia, and shingles (depending on age and health).
