



In comparing General Fund income with **actual** expenses, you will see a shortfall of \$27,293. This compares to last month when the shortfall was \$42,759.

In using the straight-line method of calculating the budget, general fund income was about \$47,758 under budget.

Using the historical average method of calculating the budget as shown above, you will see that the variance was a negative \$24,114.

Regular offering was \$50,085 under budget expectations through November, and less than 2024 by \$5,248.

General Fund offering for November was \$51,635. Historically, November results in 8.61% of general fund giving. This amount would be \$35,674.





RIC- what is it? Reconciling in Christ

The Northeast MN Synod is now an RIC synod having passed at the synod assembly last May by 96.4%. This means our synod is inclusive, welcoming and affirming of all people regardless of race, gender identity, culture, or marginalization. Each congregation in the synod can become an RIC congregation by going through a process. Welcoming others is nothing new for First Lutheran in Aitkin. Read our welcome page in our announcement sheet written by Pastor Reggie and handed out every Sunday.

In 1974 Reconciling Works: Lutherans for full participation was organized. You can find more information at Reconciling Works.org. This means respect and kindness to everyone, being open minded and non judgemental, and allowing diversity. We are all human and children of God.

The ELCA wrote a new hymn book "All Creation Sings". I want to share with you hymn 1038 "For All the Children". This speaks to all our diverse children.

1. We gather as your people to raise our song above, thought the day may not yet be here, we trust it soon will be when your children will be free

Chorus: Oh may our hearts and minds be opened, fling the church doors open wide, may there be room enough for everyone inside. For in God there is welcome, in God we all belong, may that welcome be our song.

- 2. Oh we sing for all the children, that one day they be free we sing for generations yet to be, that they never have a reason to doubt that they are blest, may they, in your love find rest.
- Oh, we pray for all the young lives cut short by fear and shame, so afraid of who they are and whom they love may the message now be banished that your love is for the few may their faith in you renew.
- 4. God, we're working for the future when children far and wide can live their lives with dignity and pride.

as they grow in strength and stature, may they join us hand in hand, as against all hate we stand.

I plan to attend an RIC workshop in January in Grand Rapids. Anyone can join me.
